THE EVI STORY SO FAR...

TIMELINE

1849

Establishment of The EVI at Penuel chapel vestry.



1855

Facilities extended

1856

Further literary & scientific lectures were given.

1930

Grants by the Miners Welfare were made between £30 and £500 for items such as books, billiard table and linoleum. 1864

The aquirement of the Irish Elk antlers was obtained from Ireland. One of the first museums in Wales was established. 1857

Several lectures, concerts and the first soirée was provided.



1958

New Education act passed by parliament.

1964

The Institute's Technical School closed due to reorganisation of Secondary Education. 1974

Continued Adult Education and Community classes under the ownership of Blaenau Gwent County Borough Council.

1930

100th Anniversary Celebrations. Serving the community since 1849.

Technical school started at the Institute.

1984

Future World Snooker Champion Mark Williams practised at the Institute.

1999

1999 marks 150 years since the Institutes foundation.



1993

Snooker tables were sold.



1980-1991

Institute continued to be home to community education and recreation.



2004

"Friends of the Institute" was created to save the facility from dereliction. 2008

Promo Cymru take over ownership of the Institue and it's Regeneration, re-establishing it as a Community and Cultural centre. 2015

The modern day institute under the continued ownership of Promo Cymru hosts concerts, rehearsal rooms, community cinema, recording studio, café, conferences, wedding receptions and parties, award ceremonies and much more.
