




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EVI'S VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

TIME CREDITS

Purpose of Role: To help the EVI team plan and deliver events at the Centre.

Responsible to: EVI Senior Development Coordinator

What will I be doing?

- Meeting and greeting event customers
- Help set up and clear down the event
- Help with registration
- Support those taking part

What skills, experience and attributes do I need?

- Enjoy meeting and talking to new people
- Be polite, friendly, and positive
- Reliable and able to work as part of a team
- Flexible and willing to work outdoors
- Enthusiastic about EVI and helping at events
- If you have specific event skills and experience that would be great but not essential

How Do I Apply?

CAFE ASSISTANTS

Purpose of Role: To assist EVI Cook/Trainer to deliver a first-class service to customers.

Responsible to: EVI Cook /Trainer

What's involved?

- Meeting and greeting customers and showing them to their tables
- Helping the Cook/Trainer to serve food and drink to tables
- Clearing empty plates and tables ready for new customers
- Ensuring the café area remains clean and tidy during service

What skills and experience do I need?

- Enjoy meeting and talking to new people
- Be polite, friendly, and positive
- Reliable and able to work as part of a team
- Happy with an active role where you will be on your feet during busy times



Training and Support

- An initial induction will be given to all volunteers
- Volunteers will also be offered the opportunity to attend accredited Hospitality Training and development sessions relevant to their roles
- Hands on experience working in hospitality
- Be part of a friendly team, work in an inspiring heritage building, and help make a difference to our community
- Be part of the EVI Time Bank, earning credits for every hour you volunteer

How Do I Apply?

COMMUNITY GARDEN VOLUNTEERS

Purpose of Role: To maintain, develop and protect our community garden so that it can be enjoyed by everyone.

Responsible to: EVI Senior Development Coordinator

What will I be doing?

- Working as part of a team
- Help with the upkeep, development and protection of the garden so that it can be enjoyed by everyone
- Tidying up
- Dead-heading/weeding
- Pruning trees, shrubs and plants
- Creating a peaceful and friendly environment for visitors to the garden

Time Commitment: To be arranged but ideally 2 hours per week



What skills, experience and attributes do I need?

- Some experience of gardening would be helpful but not essential
- Enjoy working as part of a team
- Reasonably fit
- Willing to work outdoors in all weather conditions

Training and Support

- An initial induction will be given to all new volunteers
- Volunteers will also be offered the opportunity to attend other training and development sessions relevant to their role
- You will be supported by the EVI Facilities Team
- We will hold regular volunteer meetings to provide an opportunity to give feedback and contribute ideas, as well as meeting other volunteers
- Be part of EVI Time Bank, earning time credits for every hour you volunteer

How Do I Apply?

REPAIR CAFE VOLUNTEERS

Purpose of Role: To help members of the community repair items - reducing waste and bringing the community together.

Responsible to: EVI Senior Development Coordinator

What will I be doing?

- Helping to set up the Repair Café
- Meet and greet Repair Café customers
- Helping to repair broken items
- Sharing skills with community members
- Helping with administration of Repair Café
 alongside EVI team

Time Commitment: To be arranged but ideally 2-3 hours monthly



What skills, experience and attributes do I need?

- Enjoy meeting and talking to new people
- Skilled to repair small household electrical goods, woodwork, jewellery repair, IT expertise, sewing (garment repair) or bicycle repair
- Polite, friendly and positive
- Reliable and able to work as part of a team

- Volunteers will also be offered opportunities to attend training and development sessions relevant to their roles
- Be part of a friendly team, work in an inspiring heritage building, and help make a difference in our community

Purpose of Role: To help the EVI team deliver a Smart Money Credit Union Collection Point. **Responsible to:** EVI Senior Development Coordinator

What will I be doing?

- Meeting and greeting event customers
- Help set up the Credit Union Collection Point
- Register new customers and take payments from existing customers
- Assist the Finance Officer to reconcile collections

Time Commitment: To be arranged but ideally 2–4 hours monthly

What skills, experience and attributes do I need?

- Enjoy meeting and talking to new people
- Be polite, friendly, and positive
- Reliable and able to work as part of a team
- Some experience of finance would be beneficial but not essential as training will be given
